- **GUSS – “International Summer School on the Americas”, July 17th – 31st 2011 at Seggau Castle (near Graz)**

The Summer School offers a platform to students and teachers from international universities to engage in the interdisciplinary analysis of new conceptual approaches for a redefinition of the Americas in times of worldwide globalization. The discursive and symbolic constructions of the Americas are investigated from the vantage points of **politics, history, law, literature, sustainability, film, gender, culture, and Jewish Studies**, thus contributing to the newly emerging field of “Inter-American Studies” in Europe.

The Graz University Summer School is also designed to be integrated into the curricula of **Joint Degree programs** on master level.
