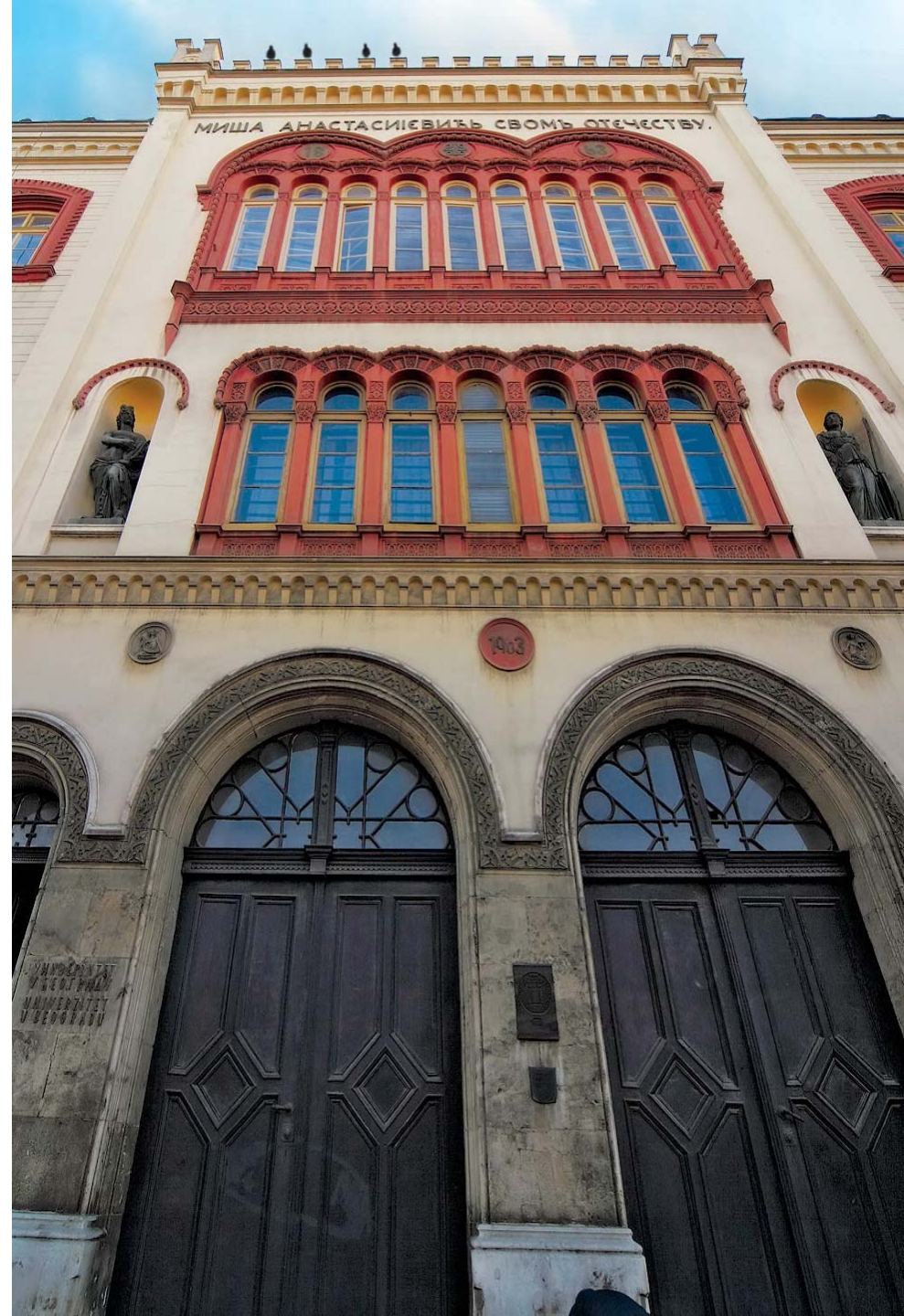

- 2.974 students with a Doctoral degree

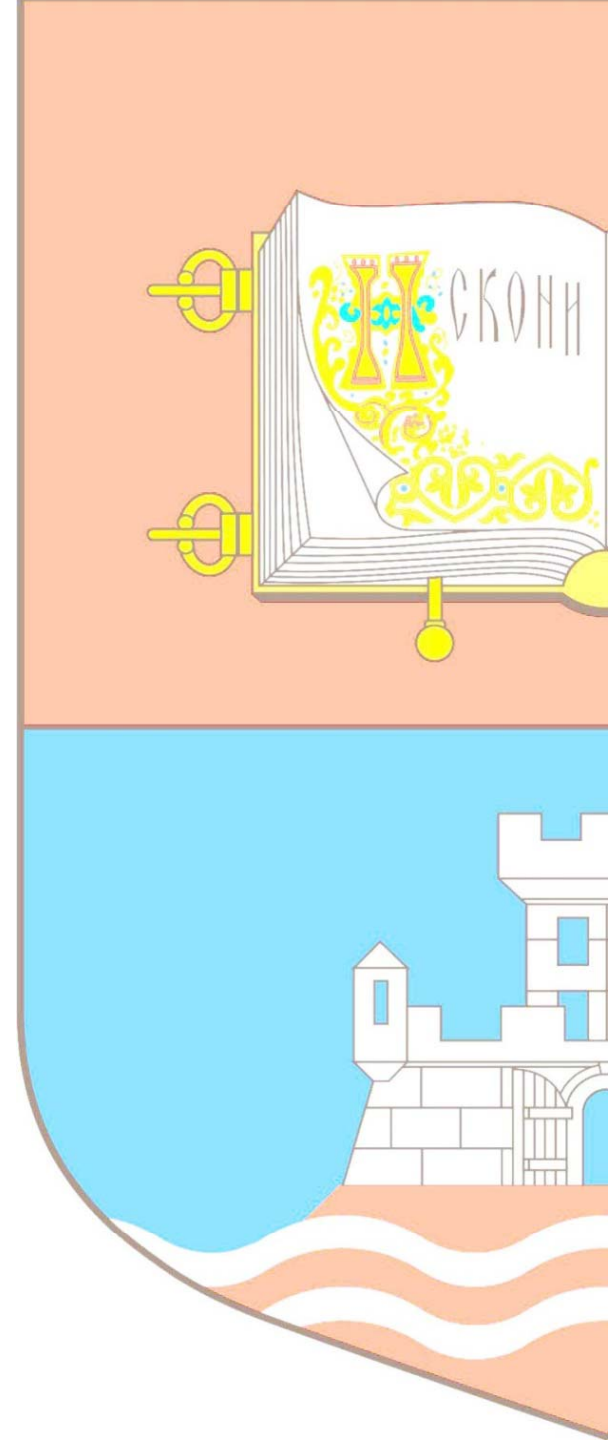

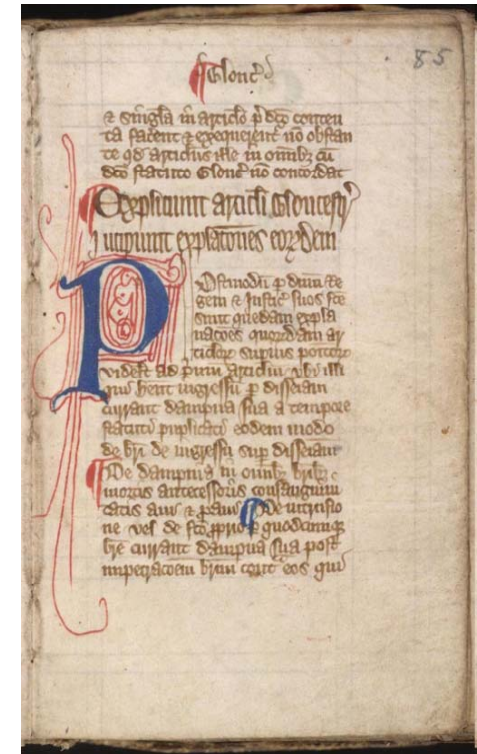
