The engaging **campus life** stimulates joint activities. Students make friends for life and build connections for their future professional careers.

The picturesque campus is located directly on the shore of Lake Wolfgang in one of Austria's most famous vacation areas. It is surrounded by meadows and woods and offers a spectacular view of the nearby mountains.

A **pier and a boat house** invite students to relax, sunbathe or meet with others. Sports trainers offer free courses throughout the duration of the summer program.

On the weekends excursions to the city of Salzburg, St. Wolfgang, and Ebensee are organized.

A dance course gives students the opportunity to learn folk dances and practice the Viennese waltz for the Midsummer Night's Ball on the last evening.

European Studies

The European Studies courses are held in English and focus on Europe and the European Union. They cover political, economic, and legal, but also historical and cultural aspects of the multiple transformations the continent is currently undergoing. The program thus offers a concise and up to date introduction to recent developments in Europe which will provide students from different fields of study with additional key qualifications for their future professional work.

German Language

The success of the German language program of the Sommerhochschule is based on careful student placement, teachers well-trained in methodology and with a special training in teaching German as a foreign language, as well as balanced communicative teaching methods. Ample opportunity for informal conversation and discussion in German will be provided by tutorials conducted by fellow Austrian students.

Courses & Credits

The four week program consists of two two-week sessions. There is a choice amongst twelve European Studies courses and four levels of German.

European Studies courses last two weeks (4 ECTS each). **German Language** courses last four weeks (6 ECTS each). Students may choose a maximum of four courses.

International - Intercultural - Interdisciplinary

The univie: summer school of the Sommerhochschule offers four weeks of European Studies and cultural exchange.

The interdisciplinary character of the European Studies courses allows students to think and learn beyond their field of study. They get the chance to work with fellow students from various academic disciplines.

Over 100 students from up to 30 nations attend the summer program every year. The diverse student body creates ideal conditions for intercultural and social learning.

The faculty consists of 16 professors devoted to the summer program. They are carefully chosen for their expertise and their motivation to teach international students.

Students are accommodated in comfortable single or double rooms on campus. Meals and accommodation can be compared to ***hotels.
