CONDITIONS:

Candidates who have completed four-year undergraduate studies (240 ECTS), as well as the candidates who have completed master academic studies, achieving at least 300 ECTS credits, after knowledge assessment relevant to attending the study programme, can enroll in study programmes in the amount of 60 ECTS credits.

Candidates who have completed three-year undergraduate studies (180 ECTS), four-year undergraduate studies (240 ECTS), as well as candidates who have completed master academic studies, achieving at least 300 ECTS credits, can enroll in study programmes in the amount of 120 ECTS credits.

Prerequisite for enrollment in a study program conducted in English is a proof of knowledge of English at a higher intermediate level of competence = B2 - Cambridge Advanced Certificate in English (CAE) or IELTS (International English Language Testing System) or completed high school education in English.

CRITERIA FOR DETERMINING THE ORDER OF APPLICANTS ON THE RANKING LIST:

The order of candidates for enrollment in the first year of master academic studies is determined on the basis of the overall average grade, the length of studies in previous studies, and interview with the candidate.

The number of points is obtained as the sum of the following elements:

- 1. Overall average grade multiplied by coefficient 4 (up to 40 points)
- 2. Number of points in the interview (up to 40 points)
- 3. The total number of points is adjusted by the length of the study in such a way that 0.25 points are deducted for each month of study after the expiration of the scheduled deadline for completion of studies, i.e., 0.25 points are added for each month of study below the scheduled deadline. For study programmes with 240 ECTS credits, the envisaged deadline is four years; for study programmes with 180 ECTS credits three years; for master academic studies of 60 ECTS credits a year, while the deadline for completion of master academic studies of 120 ECTS credits is two years.

TUITION FEE:

Citizens of the Republic of Serbia:

For study programmes in English - International Master in Taxation (60 ECTS and 120 ECTS), International Master in Business Informatics (60 and 120 ECTS), International Master in Applied Economics (60 ECTS), International Master in Quantitative Finance (60 ECTS), tuition fee is 4,000 euros per year of study.

Foreign citizens:

For study programs in English - International Master in Taxation (60 ECTS and 120 ECTS), International Master in Business Informatics (60 and 120 ECTS), International Master in Applied Economics (60 ECTS), International Master in Quantitative Finance (60 ECTS), tuition fee amounts to 6,000.00 euros per year of study.
