STUDY PROGRAM IN ENGLISH FOR WHICH A CALL HAS BEEN ANNOUNCED:

Master Academic Studies – Architecture in English (120 ECTS)

NUMBER OF VACANCIES FOR STUDENTS:

3 students are enrolled in the Master academic studies in Architecture - English language, and they pay tuition fees.

CONDITIONS:

A person who has completed undergraduate academic studies in the field of Architecture or another related field of education within the educational-scientific field of technical-technological sciences or educational-artistic field of arts defined by the Regulation on scientific, artistic, or professional fields within the educational-scientific, or educational-artistic fields ("Official Gazette of the Republic of Serbia" No. 114/17, 24/20 and 115/23) and has achieved at least 180 ECTS credits may enroll in the first year of the Master's academic studies in Architecture in Serbian and English.

The prerequisite for enrollment in a study program conducted in English is proof of knowledge of the English language at the upper intermediate level of competence = B2 – Cambridge Advanced Certificate in English (CAE) or IELTS (International English Language Testing System) or a level of knowledge that is in line with the rules of the CEFR (Common Framework of Reference for Languages).

Persons who hold a foreign higher education certificate must begin the [recognition process for the purposes of continuing education](#) no later than fifteen days before the deadline set by the faculty for applying to the call.

CRITERIA FOR DETERMINING THE ORDER OF CANDIDATES ON THE RANKING LIST:

The order of candidates for enrollment in the first year of the Master academic studies in Architecture is determined based on the success achieved in the undergraduate academic studies and the results achieved in the entrance exam.

A candidate for enrollment in the study program can earn a total of 100 points, based on the success achieved in the undergraduate academic studies and the results achieved in the entrance exam:

- success achieved in the undergraduate academic studies is valued at up to 60 points.
- the result of the entrance exam is valued at up to 40 points.

The success achieved in the undergraduate academic studies is valued by taking into account the overall average grade, multiplied by the coefficient (6). The overall average grade achieved in previous studies is calculated as follows:

$$Pr = P \times B,$$

where: P – average grade in undergraduate academic studies, B – coefficient of study time which represents a reduction factor for each additional year of study.

The value of the coefficient of study time (B) is halved for each additional three years of study, i.e. the coefficients are 0.99 - for one additional year of study, 0.67 - for two additional years of study, 0.5 - for three additional years of study and so on in the following order 0.42, 0.33, 0.25, etc. The number of points that a candidate can acquire based on the success achieved in the previous level of study is a maximum of 60.

ENTRANCE EXAM:

Candidates applying for admission to the Master academic studies in Architecture in English language take an entrance exam that is of a classification nature and includes two parts:

- quality of the portfolio as a whole – up to 20 points, and
- test (and interview) – up to 20 points.
- The candidate forms a portfolio and submits it within the deadline set for the test, together with the test. The content, number of pages and format of the portfolio, as well as the criteria for assessing quality, are specified in more detail and published in the call documentation. A candidate can earn a maximum of 20 points based on the portfolio.
- The content of the test, the duration of the test, and the method of assessment are specified in more detail and published in the call documentation. The Commission has the option to conduct an oral interview with the candidates, if necessary, upon invitation, and after the written test is completed, administer the exam. A candidate can earn a maximum of 20 points on the test.

The number of points that a candidate can earn on the basis of the entrance exam is a maximum of 40 points.

Tuition fee for the study program in English: EUR 4,000.00 (in dinar equivalent at the average NBS exchange rate on the day of payment).

Master Academic Studies – Integral Urbanism in English (120 ECTS)

NUMBER OF VACANCIES FOR STUDENTS:

2 students are enrolled in the Master academic study program in Integral Urbanism - English language, and they pay tuition fees.

CONDITIONS:

A person who has completed undergraduate academic studies in the field of Architecture or another related field of education within the educational-scientific field of technical-technological sciences or educational-artistic field of arts defined by the Regulation on scientific, artistic, or professional fields within the educational-scientific, or educational-artistic fields ("Official Gazette of the Republic of Serbia" No. 114/17, 24/20 and 115/23) and has achieved at least 180 ECTS credits may enroll in the first year of the Master's academic studies in Architecture in Serbian and English.

The prerequisite for enrollment in a study program conducted in English is proof of knowledge of the English language at the upper intermediate level of competence = B2 – *Cambridge Advanced Certificate in English (CAE)* or *IELTS (International English Language Testing System)* or a level of knowledge that is in line with the rules of the CEFR (Common Framework of Reference for Languages).

CRITERIA FOR DETERMINING THE ORDER OF CANDIDATES ON THE RANKING LIST:

A candidate for enrollment in the study program can earn a total of 100 points, based on the success achieved in the undergraduate academic studies.

The success achieved in the undergraduate academic studies is evaluated by taking into account the overall average grade, multiplied by a coefficient of ten (10). The overall average grade achieved in previous studies is calculated as follows:

$$Pr = P \times B,$$

where: P – average grade in the undergraduate academic studies, B – coefficient of study time, which represents a reduction factor for each additional year of study.

The value of the coefficient of study time (B) is halved for every additional three years of study, i.e. the coefficients are 0.99 - for one additional year of study, 0.67 - for two additional years of study, 0.5 - for three additional years of study, and so on in the following order: 0.42, 0.33, 0.25, etc. The number of points that a candidate can earn based on the success achieved in the previous level of study is a maximum of 100 points.

TUITION FEE:

Tuition fee for the study program in English: EUR 4,000.00 (in dinar equivalent at the average NBS exchange rate on the day of payment).
