STUDY PROGRAMME FOR WHICH A CALL HAS BEEN ANNOUNCED:

Specialist academic studies in English:

- **Pharmaceutical Management and Marketing (60 ECTS)**
- **Pharmaceutical Health Care (90 ECTS)**
- **Cosmetology (60 ECTS)**
- **Toxicological Risk Assessment (60 ECTS)**

NUMBER OF STUDENTS:

Enrollment in the following specialist academic study programs:

- Pharmaceutical Management and Marketing - English - 1 self-financing student
- Pharmaceutical Health Care - English - 10 self-financing students
- Cosmetology - English - 4 self-financing students
- Toxicological Risk Assessment - English - 10 self-financing students

CONDITIONS:

The right to enroll in study programs of specialist academic studies is granted to candidates who have completed: 1. undergraduate academic and master academic studies, 2. integrated academic studies in the scope of at least 300 ECTS credits, 3. Completed at least four-year studies according to the regulations that were valid until the enactment of the Law on Higher Education ("Official Gazette of the Republic of Serbia", No. 76/2005, 100/2007 - authentic interpretation, 97/2008, 44/2010, 93/2012, 89/2013, 99/2014, 45/2015 - authentic interpretation, 68/2015 and 87/2016).

The right to enroll in the specialist academic studies Pharmaceutical Management and Marketing is exercised by candidates who have graduated from the Faculty of Pharmacy with or without work experience, as well as candidates with higher professional education in the health profile and other social, natural and technical profiles with two years of experience in the pharmaceutical industry.

The right to enroll in the specialist academic studies Pharmaceutical Health Care is exercised by candidates who have graduated from the Faculty of Pharmacy.

The right to enroll in the specialist academic studies of Cosmetology is exercised by candidates who have graduated from the Faculty of Pharmacy, Medicine, Technology-Metallurgy, Chemistry and Dentistry. Candidates who have not graduated from the Faculty of Pharmacy take differential exams.

The right to enroll in the specialist academic studies of Toxicological Risk Assessment is exercised by candidates who have graduated from the Faculty of Pharmacy, Faculty of Medicine, Faculty of Dentistry, Faculty of Veterinary Medicine, Faculty of Biology, Faculty of Technology-Metallurgy, Faculty of Agriculture, Faculty of Chemistry, Faculty of Physical Chemistry and Faculty of Mathematics.

The study program Pharmaceutical Health Care will be organized if at least 5 students enroll in the aforementioned study program in both enrollment periods for both the study program accredited in Serbian and the study program accredited in English.

The prerequisite for enrollment in study programs taught in English is proof of English language proficiency at the upper intermediate level = B2 – Cambridge Advanced Certificate in English (CAE) or

IELTS (International English Language Testing System) or completed secondary school education in English.

CRITERIA FOR DETERMINING THE ORDER OF CANDIDATES:

Additional ranking conditions:

- average grade in previously completed studies
- length of study.

The order of candidates for enrollment in the first year of specialist academic studies is determined based on the overall average grade achieved in undergraduate and master academic studies, i.e. integrated studies, and the length of study in previous studies.

The general average study grade (GAG) is calculated based on the average study grades in undergraduate academic studies (GrUS) and master academic studies (GrMS), weighted by the duration of the study program in undergraduate academic and master's academic studies expressed in ECTS points (UScredit and MScredit):

$$\text{General average grade (GAG)} = \frac{\text{GrUS} \times \text{UScredit} + \text{GrMS} \times \text{MScredit}}{\text{UScredit} + \text{MScredit}}$$

For candidates who have completed integrated studies, the average grade achieved in those studies, the length of study, the achieved scientific results and other conditions prescribed by the general act of the faculty or University are evaluated.

For candidates who have acquired higher education according to the regulations that were valid before the enactment of the Law on Higher Education ("Official Gazette of the Republic of Serbia", No. 76/05, 100/07 - authentic interpretation, 97/08, 44/10, 93/12, 89/13, 99/14, 45/15 - authentic interpretation, 68/15 and 87/16), the average grade from undergraduate studies is taken, which includes the diploma thesis, if any.
