- International Business and Management, in English (90 ECTS)
- Financial Engineering in English (60 ECTS)
- Information Systems and Technologies in English (60 ECTS)

CONDITIONS:

Candidates who have previously completed the study programme of undergraduate academic studies and achieved at least 240 ECTS credits can enroll in the study program of master academic studies.

A person who has completed integrated studies, i.e. master academic studies, having achieved at least 300 ECTS credits, can also enroll in the first year of master academic studies.

Candidates who have acquired higher education according to the regulations that were valid until the enactment of the Law on Higher Education, have the right to apply for enrollment in master academic studies. Candidates who have acquired higher education by completing undergraduate studies lasting at least eight semesters have the right to apply for enrollment in master academic studies in the amount of at least 60 ECTS credits.

The study program determines the conditions for enrollment as well as appropriate and related study programs of basic academic studies. Depending on the area of accreditation of the completed basic academic study program and the acquired competencies, the possibility of continuing studies in a particular study program is determined as follows:

The prerequisite for enrollment in a study program conducted in English is proof of English language proficiency at the upper intermediate level of competence = B2 – *Cambridge Advanced Certificate in English (CAE)* or *IELTS (International English Language Testing System)* or completed secondary school education in English.

CRITERIA FOR DETERMINING THE ORDER OF CANDIDATES:

The order of candidates for enrollment in all study programmes is determined on the basis of the general average grade (GAG), the length of study at previously completed studies and the results achieved at the entrance exam.

Based on the general average grade (GAG) and the length of studies in previous studies, the candidate can gain a maximum of 40 points. The number of points based on these two criteria is calculated according to the formula:

$$\text{Min } \{40, \text{overall average grade} / \text{number of months of studying} \times \text{DoSP}\}$$

where DoSP represents the duration of the study programme, expressed in months, multiplied by 4 (four).

The number of months of study includes each started month.

The number of points based on these two criteria, obtained by the formula, is rounded to two decimal places.

The overall average grade means the average grade on previously completed undergraduate or integrated academic studies. For a candidate who has obtained a master's degree - the general average grade (GAG) is calculated on the basis of average grades of study in undergraduate academic studies (GrUS) and master academic studies (GrMS), weighted by the duration of the study program in undergraduate and master academic studies - expressed in ECTS (UScredit and MScredit).

$$\text{General average grade (GAG)} = \frac{\text{GrUS} \times \text{UScredit} + \text{GrMS} \times \text{MScredit}}{\text{UScredit} + \text{MScredit}}$$

Based on the entrance exam, the candidate can gain from 0 to 60 points.
