## SPECIAL CONDITIONS:

The Joint Master's Programme in South-East European Regional Studies (in English) is intended for candidates with completed undergraduate academic studies of at least 180 ECTS credits (bachelor's degree or equivalent), with basic knowledge of social sciences or humanities - law, politics, social, cultural or economic sciences - and general knowledge of and interest in South-East Europe. Applicants are required to submit:

1. At least one letter of recommendation (preferably from a university professor or employer, in English)
2. Certificate/diploma of completed undergraduate studies (for Graz: translated into English or German; for Belgrade: translated into English if not in a language of the former Yugoslavia)
3. Certificate of passed undergraduate studies exams (for Graz: translated into English or German; for Belgrade: translated into English if not in a language of the former Yugoslavia)
4. Motivation letter (in English)
5. Curriculum vitae (in English)
6. Proof of English language proficiency: IELTS (minimum score: 6.0), TOEFL (minimum score: 210 on the computer-based test, 547 on the paper-based test, 78 on the internet), Cambridge Exam (required level: FCE) or equivalent certificate.
7. For admission to the University of Belgrade, a certified translation of diplomas and certificates of graduation from non-Yugoslav languages into Serbian will be required at a later date.

All candidates are interviewed, after which a final decision on admission is made.

A person who has completed integrated studies, i.e. master academic studies, having achieved 300 ECTS credits at the Faculty of Political Science and other faculties determined by the study program for which they are applying may also enroll in the first year of master's studies.

## CRITERIA FOR DETERMINING THE ORDER OF CANDIDATES ON THE RANKING LIST:

The order of candidates for enrollment in the first year of master academic studies is determined based on the success achieved in undergraduate academic studies, the length of study at the previous level of study and the results achieved in the entrance exam.

The entrance exam - a test of knowledge, aptitude and abilities is held in written and / or oral form (test, essay, interview with the committee).

A candidate for enrollment in the study program can achieve a maximum of 100 points, based on the success achieved in undergraduate academic studies and the results achieved in the entrance exam.

The overall average grade in undergraduate academic studies is valued at up to 50 points.

The length of study is valued at up to 10 points, and at least 0.

The result of the entrance exam is valued at up to 40 points.

The general average grade from the UAS is the average grade from undergraduate academic studies (which also includes the grade of the final thesis, if any) and is multiplied by 5.

For a person who has completed master academic studies, the general average study grade (GAG) is calculated based on the average grades of study in undergraduate academic studies (GrUS) and master academic studies (GrMS), weighted by the duration of the study program in undergraduate academic and master academic studies, expressed in ECTS credits (UScredit and MScredit):

$$\text{General average grade (GAG)} = \frac{\text{GrUS} \times \text{UScredit} + \text{GrMS} \times \text{MScredit}}{\text{UScredit} + \text{MScredit}}$$

The length of study, for enrollment in a one-year master study, is calculated according to the formula:

$$\text{DS} = 10 - (\text{dgs} \times 4),$$

where dgs = additional year of study in undergraduate academic studies.

The length of study for enrollment in a two-year master's degree, if a three-year undergraduate academic studies has previously been completed, is calculated according to the formula:

$$\text{DS} = 10 - (\text{dgs} \times 3),$$

where dgs = additional year of study in undergraduate academic studies.

For a person who has completed undergraduate academic or integrated studies, the average grade and length of study in those studies are evaluated.

### **TUITION FEE:**

The tuition fee for the Joint Master's Program in Regional Studies of Southeast Europe - English for students who hold a domestic higher education certificate of undergraduate academic studies is 3,000 euros, and for students who hold a foreign higher education certificate of undergraduate studies is 3,600 euros, for both years of the study program.

*\* The Faculty of Political Science reserves the right not to start teaching in a study program in the 2026/2027 academic year if a sufficient number of candidates do not apply for the Call for enrollment in the first year. The Faculty will notify the Senate of the University of Belgrade upon making this decision.*
