STUDY PROGRAM FOR WHICH A CALL HAS BEEN ANNOUNCED:

Doctoral academic studies:

Physical Education and Sport – English language (180 ECTS)

NUMBER OF STUDENTS:

A total of 10 self-financing students are enrolled in the doctoral academic studies in Physical Education and Sport (in English).

CONDITIONS:

A person who has:

1. completed undergraduate academic and master academic studies, or integrated studies with at least 300 ECTS credits, or completed at least four-year studies according to the regulations that were in force before the entry into force of the Law on Higher Education ("Official Gazette of the Republic of Serbia", No. 76/05, 100/07 - authentic interpretation, 97/08, 44/10, 93/12, 89/13, 99/14, 45/15 - authentic interpretation, 68/15 and 87/16) and an overall average grade of at least 8 in undergraduate academic and master academic studies, or integrated studies, or
2. completed undergraduate academic and master academic studies, or integrated studies, with at least 300 ECTS credits with an average grade of less than 8 and completed scientific papers from the list of the relevant ministry from the category M20, M30, M50 or M60 in which the candidate must be the first author, and which supplement the number of points at least to the number of points corresponding to the average grade of 8. The evaluation of scientific papers is carried out in accordance with the Regulations on the Acquisition of Research and Scientific Titles.

A person who knows English may enroll in doctoral studies. Knowledge of English is proven by submitting a certificate from an authorized organization. In the event that a person does not possess a certificate from an authorized organization that he knows English, he is obliged to undergo a knowledge test conducted at the Faculty. The knowledge test is performed by a commission formed by the Dean of the Faculty.

CRITERIA FOR DETERMINING THE ORDER OF CANDIDATES:

The order of candidates for admission to doctoral studies is determined based on the overall average grade and length of study in undergraduate and master academic studies, achieved scientific results and other conditions prescribed by this call.

The overall average study grade (OAG) is calculated based on average grades in undergraduate academic studies (GrUS) and master academic studies (GrMS), weighted by the duration of the study program at undergraduate academic and master academic studies expressed in ECTS points (UScredit and MScredit):

$$\text{Overall average grade (OAG)} = \frac{\text{GrUS} \times \text{UScredit} + \text{GrMS} \times \text{MScredit}}{\text{UScredit} + \text{MScredit}}$$

For candidates who have completed integrated studies, the average grade achieved in those studies, the length of study, the achieved scientific results and other conditions prescribed by this call are taken into account.

For candidates who have acquired higher education according to the regulations that were in force before the entry into force of the Law on Higher Education ("Official Gazette of the Republic of Serbia", No. 76/05, 100/07 - authentic interpretation, 97/08, 44/10, 93/12, 89/13, 99/14, 45/15 - authentic interpretation, 68/15 and 87/16), the average grade from undergraduate studies, which includes the diploma thesis, if any, is evaluated.

The length of study is scored as follows:

When determining the length of study, the length of study in all study programs that candidates completed/attended from enrollment to completion of undergraduate and master's academic studies, i.e. integrated studies, i.e. four-year studies according to the regulations that were in force until the entry into force of the Law on Higher Education ("Official Gazette of the Republic of Serbia", No. 76/05) is taken into account.

In addition to the general average grade and length of study, the order of candidates for enrollment in doctoral academic studies is determined based on the following criteria:

- 1) Published scientific papers (The types and method of scoring scientific research results are defined by the Regulations on the Acquisition of Research and Scientific Titles. Scientific papers that are a mandatory condition for applying to the call for candidates with an average grade of less than 8 are not scored. A candidate in this category can achieve a maximum of 20 points).
- 2) Achieved coaching or sports results (category 1 = 6 points; category 2 = 3 points. The categorization of coaching or sports results is defined by the Regulations on the National Categorization of Top Athletes).
- 3) Professional pedagogical work at the faculty (demonstrator up to 2 years = 1.5 points; demonstrator more than 2 years = 3 points; associate 1 year = 3 points; associate 2 years = 5 points).
- 4) Diploma and master's thesis on approved departmental projects (diploma thesis = 2 points; master's thesis = 2 points).
- 5) Participation in professional and scientific projects funded by various Ministries (1 point for each project. A candidate in this category can achieve a maximum of 2 points).

The total number of points for each candidate is determined by multiplying the overall average grade, i.e. the average grade, by 5 and adding it to the points achieved based on: length of study, published scientific papers, achieved coaching or sports results, professional and pedagogical work at the faculty, diploma and master's theses on approved departmental projects, and participation in professional and scientific projects funded by various Ministries.

ENTRANCE EXAM:

Tuition fee for citizens of the Republic of Serbia: 260,000.00 dinars.

Tuition fee for foreign citizens: 3,120.00 euros.
