STUDY PROGRAMME FOR WHICH A CALL HAS BEEN ANNOUNCED:

Integrated Academic Studies of Medicine in English (360 ECTS)

NUMBER OF STUDENTS:

The Faculty of Medicine enrolls:

- for the degree of Doctor of Medicine (integrated academic studies lasting 6 years, i.e. 360 ECTS)
- studies in English, 80 self-financing students, citizens of the Republic of Serbia and foreign citizens;
- for the degree of Doctor of Medicine (integrated studies lasting 6 years, i.e. 360 ECTS) - studies in English, 50 self-financing students, under special international agreements.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS FOR ENROLLMENT:

A person who has an appropriate four-year secondary education and is medically fit for medical studies may enroll in the first year of medical studies.

Appropriate secondary education for medical studies includes high school, secondary medical school, veterinary school and other schools in the field of health.

For studies in English, the requirement is knowledge of the English language.

The prerequisite for enrollment in a study program conducted in English is proof of knowledge of the English language at the upper intermediate level of competence = B2 - *Cambridge Advanced Certificate in English (CAE)* or *IELTS (International English Language Testing System)* or completed secondary school education in English.

CRITERIA FOR DETERMINING THE ORDER OF CANDIDATES ON THE RANKING LIST:

The order of candidates for enrollment in the first year is determined based on the overall success achieved in secondary education and the results achieved in the entrance exam.

A candidate for enrollment in a study program can achieve a maximum of 100 points, based on the overall success in secondary school and the results achieved in the entrance exam.

The overall success in secondary school is understood as the sum of the average grades in each grade of secondary school multiplied by two. On this basis, a candidate can earn a minimum of 16 and a maximum of 40 points. The overall success in secondary school is calculated by rounding to two decimal places.

In the entrance exam, a candidate can earn from 0 to 60 points.

Candidates who, in the third or fourth grade of secondary school, won one of the first three prizes in a national or international competition from the competition calendar of the Ministry of Education, in the subject to be taken in the entrance exam, may be awarded the maximum number of points in that subject in the entrance exam.

ENTRANCE EXAM:

The entrance exam for medical studies in English consists of tests in Chemistry and Biology and an oral interview in English with candidates. Each test has 20 questions and each correct answer is scored with one point. The interview carries from 0 to 20 points.

The right to enroll is granted to a candidate who has scored at least 31 points on the entrance exam and is within the approved number of candidates for enrollment.

Candidates who enroll under special international agreements take an entrance exam consisting of tests in Chemistry and Biology and earn from 0 to 60 points. The right to enroll is granted to a candidate who has scored at least 31 points on the entrance exam and is within the approved number of candidates for enrollment.

ENROLLMENT PROCEDURE:

A candidate for admission to integrated academic studies of Medicine in English applies for admission in the July and September enrollment periods.

When applying for the call, a candidate-foreign citizen submits a notarized diploma of completion of a four-year high school, original documents from high school that must be translated by a court interpreter appointed by the Ministry of Justice of the Republic of Serbia and notarized by the Agency for Qualifications of the Republic of Serbia, Majke Jevrosime 52, Belgrade, an original birth certificate and a translation certified by a court interpreter appointed by the Ministry of Justice of the Republic of Serbia.

When applying for the Call, a candidate-citizen of the Republic of Serbia submits a medical certificate that he is fit for medical studies, which is issued in any Health Center or in the Student Polyclinic, Krunska 57, Belgrade.

When applying for the Call, a candidate-foreign citizen submits a medical certificate that he/she is fit to study medicine, issued by a general practitioner from the country of his/her citizenship, either at the Health Center or at the Student Polyclinic. Krunska 57, Belgrade.

A candidate-citizen of the Republic of Serbia and a foreign citizen submits proof of payment of the entrance exam fee in the amount of 140 euros in dinar equivalent.

A candidate-foreign citizen upon enrollment submits a certificate of regulated residence - MUP Belgrade - Office for Foreigners, Omladinskih brigada 1, Novi Beograd, proof of health insurance, Department for Foreign Insurance, Nemanjina 30, and all candidates also submit proof of payment of the first installment of tuition fees in the amount of 4,000.00 euros in dinar equivalent.

****TUITION FEE:**

The tuition fee for studies in English is 8,000.00 euros and can be paid in 2 installments, in equal amounts of 4,000.00 euros in dinar equivalent.
