SPECIAL CONDITIONS FOR ENROLLMENT:

A person who has completed undergraduate academic studies, having achieved at least 240 ECTS credits, may enroll in the first year of master academic studies. Also, a person who has completed integrated studies, i.e. master academic studies, having achieved at least 300 ECTS credits, as well as a person who has acquired higher education according to the regulations that were valid before the enactment of the Law on Higher Education (2005) for a duration of at least eight semesters, may enroll in the first year of master academic studies.

Candidates who have not completed a study program / module of undergraduate academic studies that is suitable for continuing their studies in a particular study program / module, take supplementary exams in a maximum of 3 specialized subjects determined by the competent expert body of the Faculty.

Students take supplementary exams before starting to take the exams stipulated by the study program / module.

The prerequisite for enrollment in a study program conducted in English is proof of English language proficiency at the upper intermediate level of competence = B2 – *Cambridge Advanced Certificate in English (CAE)* or *IELTS (International English Language Testing System)* certificate or completion of one of the previous levels of education in English.

If the candidate does not possess the appropriate certificate, the faculty organizes an English language proficiency test.

CRITERIA FOR DETERMINING THE ORDER OF CANDIDATES:

Candidates can earn 100 points based on their overall average grade, length of study, and similarity of study program structure.

The overall average grade is the average grade from their undergraduate studies multiplied by 4. On this basis, candidates can earn a maximum of 40 points.

Candidates can earn a maximum of 10 points based on their length of study. Candidates who have completed their studies on time earn 10 points on this basis, and one point is deducted for each year of

extended study.

Based on the similarity of the structure of study programs, candidates can earn a maximum of 50 points. All subjects of the previously completed study program/module are taken into account for the assessment of the similarity of the structure of study programs. The assessment of the similarity of the structure of study programs is carried out by the competent expert body of the Faculty. The assessment of the similarity of the structure of study programs and modules is carried out by the competent expert body of the Faculty according to the formula:

$$\text{BSSP} = \frac{50}{\text{BPSP}} \times \text{BEP}$$

Where: BSSP - number of points based on the similarity of the structure of study programs/modules, BPSP - number of subjects of the study program/module that the candidate has completed and BEP - number of subjects that are equivalent to the home study program.

The order of candidates on the ranking list for each study program is determined based on the total points earned.

TUITION FEE:

Tuition fee for citizens of the Republic of Serbia: 106,000.00 dinars.

Tuition fee for foreign citizens: 2,200.00 euros.
