## **STUDY PROGRAM IN ENGLISH FOR WHICH THE CALL HAS BEEN ANNOUNCED:**

**Law and Gender, Intersectionality and Diversity - 120 ECTS credits - *Erasmus Mundus Joint Master***, joint study program of the University of Belgrade Faculty of Law, LUMSA University – Department of Law, Economics and Communication in Palermo and Örebro University – Faculty of Social Sciences and Humanities

## **NUMBER OF VACANCIES FOR STUDENTS:**

The Master's degree program in Law and Gender, Intersectionality and Diversity, worth 120 ECTS credits, taught in English, is open to 60 self-financing students, of which 13 will receive a scholarship from the European Commission within the *Erasmus Mundus Joint Master* program (application deadline for scholarships: April 19, 2026; application deadline for students who will cover their own study costs: June 15, 2026).

## **SPECIAL ENROLLMENT CONDITIONS:**

The following candidates are eligible to enroll:

- who have completed undergraduate academic studies of 180 ECTS credits within a three-year study program or 240 ECTS credits within a four-year study program (including persons who have completed undergraduate four-year studies under the laws that were valid before the enactment of the Law on Higher Education);
- who have completed integrated academic studies, i.e. master academic studies with at least 300 ECTS credits;
- who have proof of knowledge of the English language at the upper intermediate level of competence - B2: e.g. certificates: Cambridge Advanced Certificate in English (*CAE*), International English Language Testing System (*IELTS*), or a certificate of qualifications corresponding to the course "English 6" or "English B" from a Swedish secondary school, which is in accordance with the upper intermediate level B2, or a certificate of completion of secondary school in English.

The first semester is held at the University of Belgrade – Faculty of Law, the second at LUMSA University – Department of Law, Economics and Communication in Palermo, the third at the Örebro University – Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences, while students choose which university they will write their final thesis at during the fourth semester.

## **CRITERIA FOR DETERMINING THE ORDER OF CANDIDATES ON THE RANKING LIST:**

The order of candidates is determined based on the following criteria: 1) previous academic results (60% - up to 60 points); 2) English language skills (20% - up to 20 points); 3) motivation and recommendations (10% - up to 10 points); 4) additional academic, research and professional experience (10% - up to 10 points). The maximum number of points that candidates can achieve is 100.

**TUITION FEE:**

Tuition fee for citizens of the Republic of Serbia: 160,000.00 dinars.

Tuition fee for foreign citizens: 2,400.00 euros.

\*Self-financing students pay the stated tuition fee to the University of Belgrade - Faculty of Law for the entire duration of the program (two years), but they themselves cover the costs of travel, accommodation and subsistence during the semesters held at LUMSA University in Palermo and at the Örebro University.
