STUDY PROGRAMME FOR WHICH A CALL HAS BEEN ANNOUNCED:

Integrated Academic Studies of Dental Medicine in English (360 ECTS)

NUMBER OF VACANCIES FOR STUDENTS:

Study Programme in English - 20 self-financing students.

CONDITIONS:

Candidates who have completed a four-year secondary education, namely a general secondary school or a medical secondary school, are eligible to apply.

For enrolment in the Integrated Academic Studies of Dental Medicine in English, a candidate who is a foreign national is required to submit a certificate of proficiency in Serbian and English at the intermediate level - B2, issued by the Institute of Foreign Languages.

CRITERIA FOR DETERMINING THE ORDER OF CANDIDATES ON THE RANKING LIST:

The ranking of candidates for enrolment in the first year of Integrated Academic Studies of Dental Medicine is determined on the basis of the secondary education grade point average and the results achieved in the entrance exam. A candidate may obtain a maximum of 100 points in total, based both on the secondary school grade point average and the results achieved the entrance exam.

The secondary education grade point average refers to the sum of all grade averages from the first, second, third, and fourth years, multiplied by two. On this basis, a candidate can receive at least 16 and up to 40 points. The overall average grade for secondary education is rounded to two decimal places.

The result that a candidate achieves in the entrance exam is evaluated from 0 to 60 points (up to 30 points per subject).

The School determines a unique ranking list for candidates. A candidate's place on the final ranking list and the total number of points achieved determine whether they can be admitted to the first year of Integrated Academic Studies of Dental Medicine.

A candidate may enrol in the study programme as a self-financing student providing that they are placed on the final ranking list within number determined for self-financing enrolments and have achieved at least 30 points.

ENTRANCE EXAM:

At the entrance exam, candidates take tests in Chemistry and Biology, each scored on a scale from 0 to 30 points per subject.

TUITION FEE:

The tuition fee for the study programme in English is 7,000.00 EUR, applicable to both citizens of the Republic of Serbia and foreign nationals.

***Enrolment in the study programme in English is conducted during the September admission period.**
