Master academic studies:

- Forestry and Natural Resources Management – in English (120 ECTS)

SPECIAL ENROLLMENT CONDITIONS:

A person from the Republic of Serbia or abroad who has completed undergraduate academic studies in the field of Forestry or another related field of education within the educational and scientific field of technical and technological sciences and has achieved at least 180 ECTS credits can enroll in the first year of master academic studies in the English language study program Forestry and Natural Resources Management.

As proof of knowledge of the English language, the candidate must have the *Cambridge Advanced Certificate in English (CAE)* / *IELTS - International English Language Testing System*, a compatible diploma or completed secondary school education in English.

CRITERIA FOR DETERMINING THE ORDER OF CANDIDATES ON THE RANKING LIST:

The order of candidates for enrollment in master academic studies is determined based on: the overall average grade achieved in previously completed studies, the length of study of the previous level of study, the compatibility of the study program, the motivation letter and additional achieved results.

Candidates can earn 100 points.

Based on the overall average grade, the length of study and the compatibility of the study program, candidates can earn a maximum of 30 points, of which a maximum of 10 points for overall success, 10 points for the length of study and 10 points for the compatibility of the study program with the "Forestry and Natural Resources Management" program;

Based on the motivation letter, candidates can earn a maximum of 30 points;

Based on the additional results achieved, candidates can achieve a maximum of 40 points, as follows:

- scientific papers published in journals from the SCI list - number x 2 points;
- scientific papers published in journals of national importance or at scientific conferences - number x 1 point;

- participation in scientific projects - number x 1 point;
 - professional papers - number x 0.5 points;
 - awards or recognitions - number x 1 point;
 - additional scientific or professional training - number x 1 point;
 - work experience in the professional field of Forestry - number of years x 1 point;
 - work experience outside the professional field of Forestry - number of years x 0.5 points;
- The total number of points achieved in this category cannot exceed 40.

TUITION FEE:

The tuition fee for the English-language study program Forestry and Natural Resources Management is 1,450.00 euros (for citizens of the Republic of Serbia, as well as for foreign citizens).
